7 Prayers For Healing and Revival in America

We don't need to look very hard to see that the people of the United States of America are hardly "united". We know that the enemy "prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour" 1

Peter 5:8 and it's clear that sowing division amongst the church has been a heavily utilized tactic.

Christians understand that we are in the midst of a spiritual battle that can only be fought with spiritual weaponry, ie. prayer. God can restore His people and our nation through a spiritual revival. "Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?" Psalm 85:6

As a country, we know we must put God first and foremost in order to survive this spiritual warfare and experience a revival. And a revival won't happen unless believers unite in fervent prayer and seek God's face. "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

Prayer 1 - Revival Starts With Your People

PRAYER: Lord, revival starts with your people. We pray for a revival in the church and among your people. We cry out to you, "revive us again; fill each heart with thy love." Let your glory shine, oh Lord. Amen.

MESSAGE: What Does Revival Mean?

BIBLE VERSE: Won't you revive us again, so your people can rejoice in you? - Psalm 85:6

Prayer 2 - God We Trust

Prayer 4 - One Nation Under God

BIBLE VERSE: Now the whole world had one language and a common speech. As people moved eastward, they found a plain in Shinar and settled there. They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar. Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves; otherwise we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth. But the Lord came down to see the city and the tower the people were building. The Lord said, "If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them. Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will not understand each other."So the Lord scattered them from there over all the earth, and they stopped building the city. That is why it was called Babel because there the Lord confused the language of the whole world. From there the Lord scattered them over the face of the whole earth. - Genesis 11:1-9

Prayer 6 - Mercy For Our Country

MESSAGE: Asking for God's Mercy on Our Country

BIBLE VERSE: "Now, our God, hear the prayers and petitions of your servant. For your sake, Lord, look with favor on your desolate sanctuary. Give ear, our God, and hear; open your eyes and see the desolation of the city that bears your Name. We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy. Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! For your sake, my God, do not delay, because your city and your people bear your Name."- Daniel 9:17-19

Prayer 7 - Revival

MESSAGE: Where Revival Begins

BIBLE VERSE: And Saul approved of their killing him. On that day a great persecution broke out against the church in Jerusalem, and all except the apostles were scattered throughout Judea and Samaria. Godly men buried Stephen and mourned deeply for him. But Saul began to destroy the church. Going from house to house, he dragged off both men and women and put them in prison. Those who

had been scattered preached the word wherever they went. Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Messiah there. When the crowds heard Philip and saw the signs he performed, they all paid close attention to what he said. For with shrieks, impure spirits came out of many, and many who were paralyzed or lame were healed. So there was great joy in that city. - Acts 8:1-8
