
HOW CHRISTIANS CAN PRAY FOR THE POLITICAL CANDIDATE THEY WON'T BE VOTING FOR

The United States Presidential election season is not only upon us;

it's in full swing through every state and territory where citizens can legally vote. A huge voting block is comprised of Christians, and the candidates will vie for our support and endorsements. Differences aside, no matter which election season we face, how should we pray for the "other guy" — the candidate we choose not to support?

Even within our faith, differences between denominations amass over issues that, for some, will prevent them from voting for a particular person. Whether single-issue or "whole package" voters, as Christians, it's our privilege to cast a vote based on how our faith leads us.

However, we need to be careful to refrain from heated discussions with people who have opposing views. The Bible tells us to "Let your reasonableness be known to everyone" (Philippians 4:5). The passage continues by telling Christians the Lord is at hand and His peace will guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:6-7). As we interact with other voters and discover differences in values, we are to pray in our hearts and with other believers with thankfulness to the Lord and be peaceable.

The other person, whether Christian or not, will see our behavior and remember our actions. The best outcome? They will glorify God because of us (Galatians 1:24).



HOW DO I PRAY FOR THE PERSON I CHOOSE NOT TO **SUPPORT?**

Christians cannot be spectators only. Our role as Christians in politics is to obey the Lord and subject ourselves to the authorities God has placed over us. We owe our loyalty first to the Lord and we are to reflect His image to a lost and dying world.

What can we do? As kingdom dwellers here on earth, we can do much, starting with <u>prayer</u>. Learn what you can about the candidates. Then pray some more and vote according to who you are in Christ and how His Spirit leads you through His Word. Remember, no matter who is in office and no matter what laws are enacted, "we must obey God rather than men" (Acts 5:29).

Following are prayers for the candidate we choose not to support.





1. PRAYER FOR WISDOM

Father God,

I pray for this candidate today that you will give him or her wisdom as they run for office. As the candidate selects their running mate and maybe has to replace members of his or her staff or choose where to go and to whom they will speak, give them wisdom from above since they will be the leader of this nation. Give the candidate wisdom to understand all the many issues and facts that are presented to them. And help them decide on the best way to move forward — the best way to govern with a keen eye for trouble and a compassionate heart for the citizens over whom they have authority.

Help the candidate to know what is best for the people and for the nation.





2. PRAYER FOR ADVISORS

May this candidate gain the honest favor and trust of advisers who do not walk partisan lines, but instead, will seek the best for the people of the nation. Help the candidate with clarity of mind and focus as they choose who will "run" the country with them.

If this candidate does not win the election, may their advisors give the best counsel to lose graciously, and offer to help heal any wounds inflicted during any contentious debates or actions that occurred during their candidacy.







3. PRAYER FOR GRACE

5. PRAYER FOR TRUTHFULNESS
