The Story at a Glance

When King Nebuchadnezzar commanded everyone to bow to a golden image, three young men — Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego — stood firm in their faith. Their refusal to worship a false god led to their being thrown into a fiery furnace... but God did not abandon them.

“The God we serve is able to deliver us... But even if He does not, we will not serve your gods.”
— Daniel 3:17–18

Backstory: Faith in Exile

- Daniel and his friends were taken from Israel to Babylon during the exile.
- Despite pressure to conform, they remained faithful to God.
- God honored their obedience with wisdom, knowledge, and favor (Daniel 1:17).
- Their faith set the stage for God’s miraculous power to be displayed before kings.

In the Furnace: Faith Tested

COMMAND: Worship the golden image or die.

RESPONSE: “We will not bow.”

CONSEQUENCE: Thrown into a blazing furnace heated seven times hotter.

MIRACLE: A fourth figure appears, protecting them from harm.

RESULT: Not a hair singed; the king declares the power of the true God.
