"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

-Proverbs 3:5–6 (NIV)

Trusting God does not mean we stop thinking, planning, or making wise decisions. It means we refuse to make our own understanding the final authority. We place our plans, questions, and future into God's hands, trusting that His wisdom is greater than ours and His direction is always faithful.



What Is Making Trust Difficult Today?

1. WAITING

Waiting can make us wonder whether God has forgotten us. Yet God is present and active even when we cannot see an answer. He can renew our strength, deepen our faith, and prepare us for what comes next.

God's Truth ...

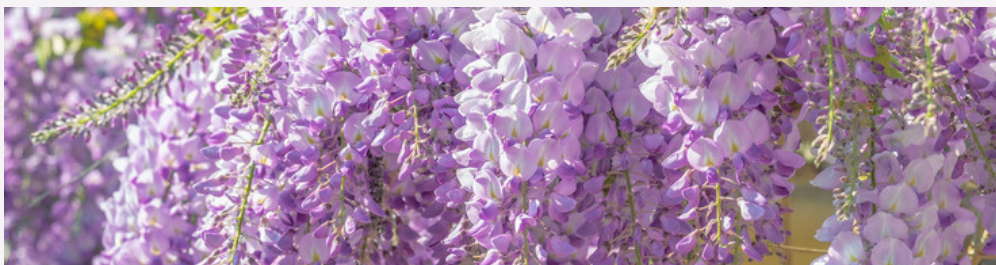
"But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength."

What Is Making Trust Difficult Today?

2. DISTRACTIONS

A busy schedule and a noisy mind can make it difficult to hear God's voice. Intentionally spending time with Him reminds us that we are deeply loved and never alone.

"See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!" —1 John 3:1a (NIV)

Choose trust ...

What can I set aside today so I can be still with Him?

3. THE DESIRE FOR CONTROL

We often want to know how a decision or situation will turn out before we surrender it to God. Remembering His faithfulness helps us release the outcome and trust Him with our next step.

God's Truth ...

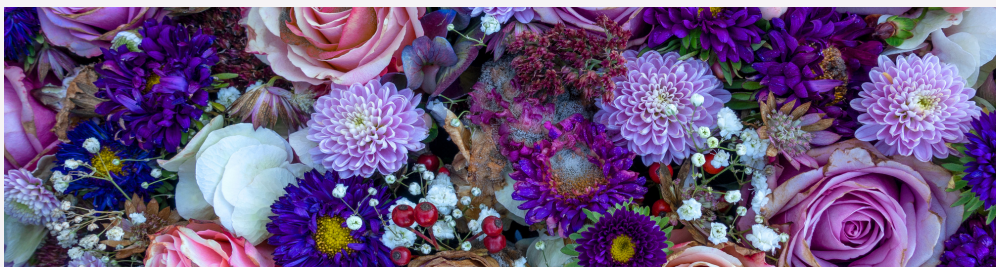
"For this God is our God for ever and ever; he will be our guide even to the end." —Psalm 48:14 (NIV)
